**ENTRY FEE:** Conformation is \$30.00 for the first entry of each dog. Each additional Conformation entry of the same dog will be \$25.00. Obedience is \$30.00 for the first entry of each dog. Each additional Obedience entry of the same dog will be \$25.00. Team Class (Obedience) as an only or additional (per unit) is \$30.00 and at least one of the unit dogs must also be entered in another class at this show at the regular entry fee. Sweepstakes Classes are \$25.00. JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP is \$25.00 as a first entry or as an additional entry. First Rally Entry is \$30.00. Each additional Rally Entry of the same dog will be \$25.00. Fees include the 50¢ AKC Recording Fee and the \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee on the first entry of a dog and a \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee for each additional entry of the same dog in the regular and non-regular recordable single entry classes, or the \$3.50 AKC Recording Fee on each entry of a dog in Rally and a \$3.00 for each additional entry of the same dog. 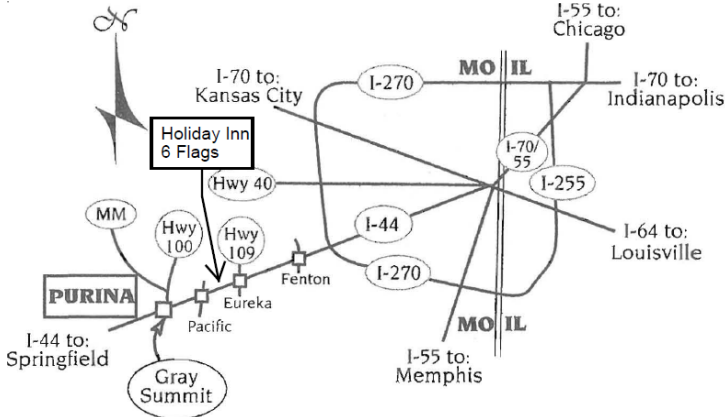

## **PURINA FARMS ACCESS and USE**

- RV's may park at Purina Farms starting at Noon, Saturday, April 4th. Reservation with pre-payment for entire stay is required.
- Unloading into the Great Hall may begin on Saturday April 4th at 3 p.m. and thereafter while the building is unlocked. Note that dogs cannot be left in the Hall after 6 p.m. Unless special agreement from Purina is granted, the facility will be open from 6 a.m. until 6 p.m..
- Grooming in the building is only allowed in the Gateway Hall. Grooming spaces will be outlined.
- Towels or some other form of padding is required under the crates to protect the floor in the Great Hall.
- For grounds maintenance, and in order to maintain cleanliness at the hotel and show site, PLEASE, it is imperative that you pick up after your dog. There will be bags and trash receptacles provided for that purpose. There is a public x-pen area on the East side of Gateway Hall.
- No exercise pens allowed around the front of the Purina Event Center and exercise pens around the perimeter of the entire building are strongly discouraged.
- The Purina Cafe will be open every day inside at the Great Hall (show site). Please note: outside food cannot be brought into the building.

## **Flat-Coated Retriever Society of America, Inc.**

Thursday, April 9, 2015

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers. This series of special competitions will be offered at select dog shows across the country.

All dogs that are owner/handled and are not owned or exhibited by professional handlers\* meet the requirements for this competition.

- Exhibitors must declare their dog is AKC National Owner-Handled Series eligible at the time of entry using the check box on the entry form.
- The handler must be an owner of record according to the AKC's records as of the date of the show.
- Dogs declared eligible will be identified by an asterisk or other representative mark in the stewards book and in the show catalog.
- Professional handlers, household members & current assistants to professional handlers may not exhibit. A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or, assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend.
- **Dogs must be handled by an owner-handler eligible for the AKC National Owner-Handled Series throughout the breed level competition for the regular show. This includes the class competition & subsequent competition in the breed ring. Additionally, dogs must be handled by an eligible owner-handler for all AKC National Owner-Handled Series competition.**
- The Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the eligible dogs that competed in the Best of Breed competition for the regular show. This includes Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and the undefeated winners of the non-regular classes.

*This excludes all dogs defeated during class & winners competition for the regular show.*

- If the Best of Breed winner of the regular show is eligible for the AKC National Owner-Handled Series competition, it will also be awarded Owner-Handled Best of Breed.
- If the regular show Best of Breed winner is not eligible for AKC National Owner-Handled Series competition and the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed is eligible, the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed will compete against the eligible exhibits of the other sex to determine Owner-Handled Best of Breed.
- If neither the Best of Breed nor the Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed from the regular show is eligible and both the Select Dog & Select Bitch are eligible, the judge is to choose Owner-Handled Best of Breed from the Selects and any eligible Winners Dog or Winners Bitch.
- If one of the Selects from the regular show is eligible excuse all eligible champions & non-regular class winners of the same sex and then choose Owner-Handled Best of Breed from the remaining eligible dogs of the opposite sex including the eligible Winners.
- If the Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog & Select Bitch from the regular show are not eligible, the judge may choose any eligible dog who competed in Best of Breed including Winners Dog or Winners Bitch as the Owner-Handled Best of Breed.

*\*Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.*

No entry may be changed or cancelled unless notice of the change or cancellation is received in writing by the Superintendent or Show Secretary named in the premium list to receive entries, prior to the closing date and hour for entries, except that a correction may be made from one age division to another provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary at least one half-hour prior to the scheduled start of any Junior Showmanship class at the show.

Each dog entered in a regular Junior Showmanship Class must be of a Retrievers (Flat-Coated) eligible to compete in the conformation classes at the event. In the spirit of good sportsmanship, and to showcase Flat-Coated Retrievers as a primarily owner-handled breed, dogs shown in FCRSA Veterans Sweepstakes or Puppy Sweepstakes classes should be exhibited by their owner, co-owner, breeder, or other non-professional handler. Professional handlers may only handle dogs that they own, co-own, or have bred.

A professional handler is defined as someone who shows dogs at licensed AKC/CKC shows for a fee. Members of a professional handler's household also are not eligible to participate. However, Junior Handlers that are members of a professional handler's household are not considered professional handlers, and are eligible to participate.

Armbands will be required to be picked up from the Ring Steward at least 30 minutes prior to judging of the class and at that time the handler will be noted by the Ring Steward. Handler eligibility will be verified prior to entering the ring.

Complaints about eligibility must be made in WRITING and will be investigated following judging by the Ethics Committee. Ribbons will be withdrawn and prize money returned if a handler is deemed ineligible to show the dog. All winning dogs will have handler's name appear in the Specialty Newsletter.

(Variety) If you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e. Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color). Beagles (not exceeding 13 in.; over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.) Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired). Collies (rough, smooth). Bull Terriers (colored, white). Manchester Terriers (standard, toy). Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat). English Toy Spaniels (King Charles & Ruby, Blenheim & Prince Charles). Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record; and dogs, which, according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to AKC (For complete rules refer to Chapter 11, Section 3).
